Local artist Tim Murton's monsters highlight the "Twilight Zoo" at the arts centre and can be found scattered through the village, and are complemented by the new Elora Halloween Scare Fair and a long-running Monster March walking parade.

Winter is a magical time when snow and frost paint the trees, and icicles as tall as a house form throughout the gorge. Every season offers something new and beautiful for visitors and locals alike.

Best of all, Fergus and Elora are merely minutes apart, so you have time to do it all and experience the uniqueness that makes up Centre Wellington.
