### Boat, Kayak & Canoe Rentals/Regulations

- Driver's license and refundable deposit are required for all boat rentals to cover damage or loss of equipment
- Minimum rental time is 1/2 hour
- Rental rates are calculated to the 1/2 hour
- All persons using park boats must wear a personal flotation device, regardless of age
- No alcoholic beverages permitted
- \$10 late fee charged if returned after scheduled rental time

### Horsepower Limits

- Sippo Lake and Walborn Reservoir – 10 hp
- Deer Creek Reservoir – Electric motors only
- Ohio & Erie Canal – Carry-in boats only; no motors allowed

### Personal Boats

- Free public ramps for launching boats at Walborn Reservoir, Deer Creek Reservoir, and Sippo Lake Park (Sippo Lake up to 21 feet)

- All private boats must display current Ohio Boating Registration sticker and number
- All **personal boats** must be off the lakes **30 minutes before park closing**
- Personal pontoon boats prohibited on Sippo Lake

### Pontoon Boat Rentals ● \$30/Hour

- Call 330.409.8096 for reservations
- Available by reservation only at least two weeks in advance
- Available at Sippo Lake and Walborn Reservoir
- Captain and personal flotation devices provided
- Maximum of seven riders at Walborn and nine at Sippo, and two hours cruises
- Cruises are subject to cancellation due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances
- Cancellations must be made 24 hours in advance to receive a refund
- Personal pontoon boats are permitted in Walborn Reservoir only and must obey limits

### ODNR Ohio Boating Education Classes

- Offered periodically; proficiency testing by appointment
- Required for those driving a powerboat over 10 hp
- Classes offered through Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) Division of Watercraft at watercraft.ohiodnr.gov

## Fishing

Fishing regulations apply to all public waters in Ohio, EXCEPT site-specific regulations. Refer to current ODNR "Ohio Fishing Regulations & Limits" available at wildlife.ohiodnr.gov.

### Fishing Licenses

Anyone 16 or older requires a fishing license. Licenses are available at both marinas and must be paid for with Mastercard/Visa.



Accessible fishing piers are available at Walborn Reservoir, Deer Creek Reservoir, Sippo Lake Park, and Lock 4 Trailhead.

### Stark Parks Annual Fishing Events

Stark Parks and partners, including the Berkley Fishing Team and The Stark County Federation of Conservation Clubs, offer a **children's fishing circuit April through September**. Derby registration is required to be eligible for a \$250 cash prize as part of a circuit drawing.\* Derbies are for ages 4 - 15 unless noted otherwise. Stark Parks also offers two night derbies in July and August. Both are open to the public and offer cash prizes.

# Hunting

Public hunting is permitted in designated areas in Deer Creek and Walborn Reservoirs during regular hunting seasons. All hunters are required to have a valid Ohio hunting license and follow all State and Federal regulations. Additional regulations, as determined by Stark Parks, are posted and available online at [StarkParks.com](http://StarkParks.com).

## Deer Hunting

Archery hunting for white-tailed deer is permitted in all areas posted as open hunting. While hunting with a tree stand is permitted, it must be removed daily and no spikes or steps are to be placed into any trees. **Walborn Reservoir is restricted to archery hunting only.** Deer Creek Reservoir is open for archery and gun seasons as detailed by ODNR Division of Wildlife in the current seasons *Hunting and Trapping Regulations* or at [wildlife.ohiodnr.gov](http://wildlife.ohiodnr.gov).

## Small Game

Walborn and Deer Creek Reservoirs allow small game hunting in open hunting areas, as designated in the map below. For updated State regulations, go to [wildlife.ohiodnr.gov](http://wildlife.ohiodnr.gov) *Hunting and Trapping Regulations*.

## Furbearer Trapping

Trapping is allowed at Deer Creek and Walborn Reservoirs **only** with registration through Stark Parks, for a free annual fur takers permit. Trappers must adhere to all State and Federal regulations. Please call 330.477.3552 for additional information or to receive a permit.

## Duck Blinds

Ten permanent waterfowl blinds on the main body of Walborn Reservoir are available for daily rental with the exception of Tuesdays and Thursdays during the regular waterfowl season. The main body is located between Marlboro Avenue and Price Street.



Blind 7A is accessible and is approximately 200 yards from the parking area on Reeder Ave.

A lottery for the use of these ten waterfowl blinds at Walborn Reservoir is held annually in September, at Walborn Reservoir Marina, northwest of Alliance on Price Street. Registration for the lottery typically begins at 8 a.m., with the drawing to take place at 9 a.m. (however dates and times are subject to change). Duck blind reservations can also be made after the lottery. Call 330.409.8096 for available blinds and dates.

Hunters must be present for the drawing to claim their days. All Ohio and Federal hunting regulations apply. All blinds will be available for daily use, and nonrefundable fees of \$10 per day must be paid in cash or by check on the day of the lottery. Participants must bring the following:

- Photo identification
- Last or current year's hunting license
- Last or current year's federal and state duck stamps

After the annual lottery, Stark Parks accepts open reservations. If you are making a reservation for the first time, bring all required materials to the Exploration Gateway at 5712 12th Street NW in Canton. After approval you will be able to make duck blinds reservations in person or online at [StarkParks.com](http://StarkParks.com).

Blinds are also available for early goose season and youth season. Areas to the north of Price Street and south of German Church Road, east of Stroup Road, and all of Deer Creek (electric motor only) are available for open waterfowl hunting from your boat.
