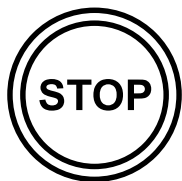




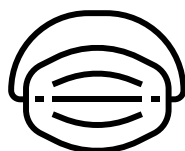

A few things to ensure the safety of our guests and team:



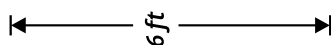
1 DO NOT VISIT IF...

Please do not visit if you have a fever or symptoms of respiratory infection, returned from overseas in the last 14 days, or been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19.



2 FACE COVERINGS REQUIRED

Guests are not permitted in the park unless they are wearing a face covering. The only exceptions are while dining, or if a guest is under the age of two. Face masks must be worn on rides. For safety reasons, face shields are not permitted on rides, but can be utilized elsewhere in the park.



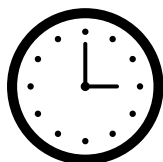
3 MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING

Maintain social distancing of six feet and follow in-park indicators. This could result in limited capacity for rides and gift shops.



4 WASH HANDS FREQUENTLY

Wash hands with soap and water for 20 seconds, or with hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available. Approximately 150 hand sanitizer stations are located throughout the park.



5 PLAN FOR EXTRA WAIT TIME

Due to social distancing and frequent sanitizing of high-touch points, you might experience increased wait times.



6 EXPECT CLOSURES

Frequent sanitizing could mean temporary closures of rides, food stands, gift shops, games or restrooms. Some rides, food stands, gift shops, games and attractions will be unavailable this year.



7 FOLLOW SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please follow all written and verbal safety instructions, and be respectful of fellow park guests and our team.
