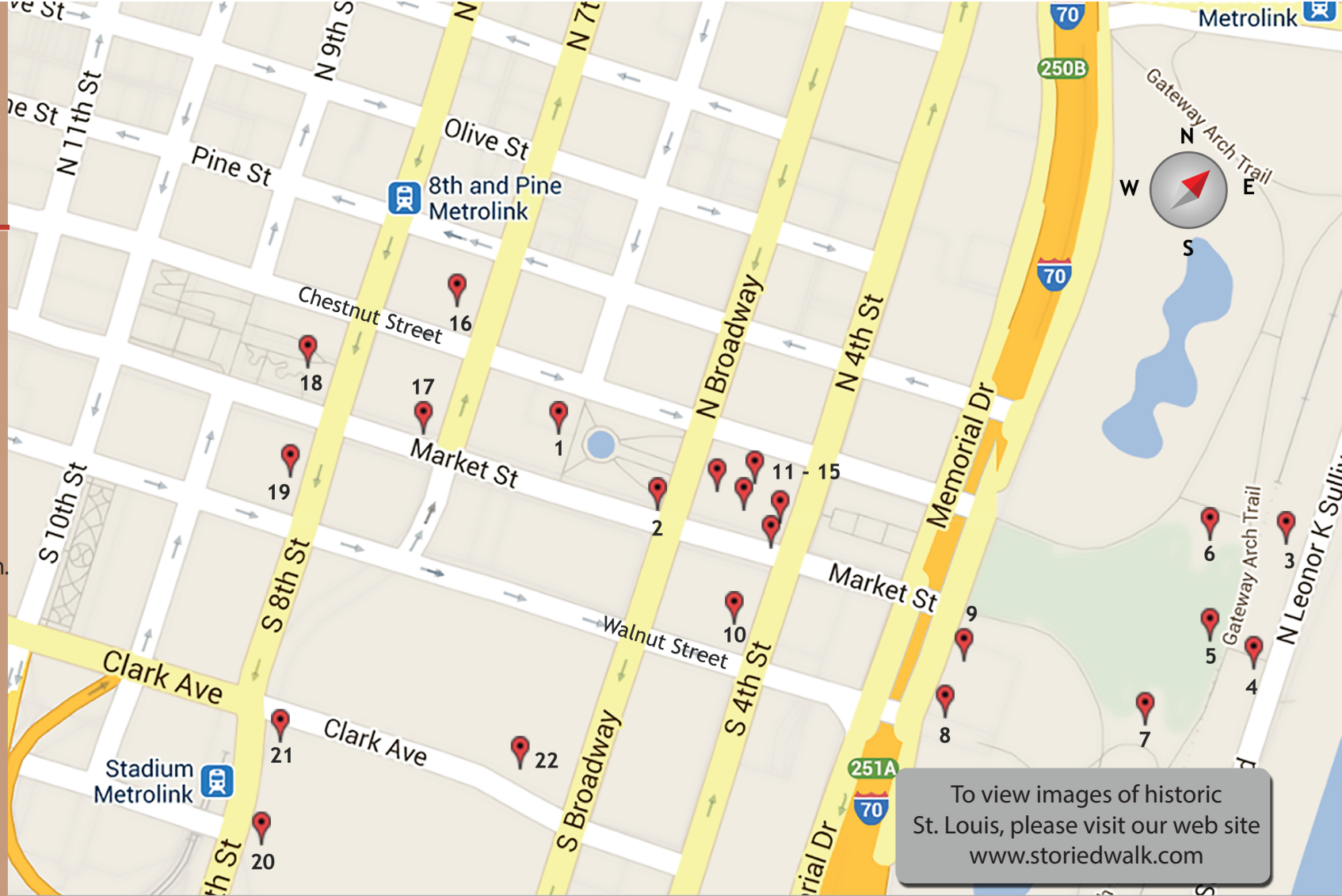

1. Instructions and helpful hints for your tour.
2. Introduction to St. Louis, walk to riverfront, bottom of Gateway Arch steps.
3. Riverfront, walking along Leonor K. Sullivan Boulevard. Learn more about St. Louis founder.
4. Paddleboat Era, return up Arch steps while hearing a story about Mark Twain.
5. Great Flood of 1993, top of Arch steps.
6. Arch fun facts, north leg of Gateway Arch.
7. Colonial St. Louis, south leg of Gateway Arch.
8. Old Cathedral, Walnut Street & Memorial Dr.
9. Madame Chouteau, grove behind Old Cathedral.
10. Laclede/Chouteau family history, walk to Old Courthouse via Walnut & 4th Street.
11. International Fur Exchange, 4th & Market.
12. Quigley's Turtle, Old Courthouse fence.
13. Lynch's Slave Pen, Old Courthouse steps.
14. Dred Scott Case, Old Courthouse interior.
15. Civil War, Old Courthouse rotunda. Begin walk to next stop.
16. Wainwright Building, 7th & Chestnut, stand on the northwest corner.
17. Gateway Mall, walk to next stop via Market Street to view mall.
18. Citygarden, 8th & Market.
19. Henry Shaw, listen to story while walking south on 8th Street to Busch Stadium.
20. Musial Plaza, 8th & Spruce.
21. Plaza of Champions, corner of 8th & Clark St.
22. Ballpark Village, end of tour.

Audio Player Instructions



Firstly insert the headset and remove the battery tag on the player back

Press B to Power On. A red light indicates the Power is On.

Press C to Play, once again to Pause if required and again to return to Play. A flashing red light indicates the unit is playing.

Press D to Track forward.

Press A to Track back.

Volume is adjusted by using the + and - controls.

If the guide is NOT working check that the headset is inserted and the battery tag has been removed.

If you remove the headset, the unit will pause - simply reconnect to start the unit again.

Replacement batteries 3 x LR44 1.5v.
