#### **Directions to 75 Falmouth Heights Road:**

From the Bourne Bridge, follow Rte. 28 South for approximately 13 miles to the first set of traffic lights. Turn left at Falmouth Hospital sign onto Jones Road (Hyannis Bypass). Go through first set of lights to second set of lights (Rte. 28). Turn right onto Davis Straits (Rte. 28) then bear left onto Falmouth Heights Road. The Island Queen parking lot is 1/4 mile on right. The dock and ticket office are located a short distance from the parking lot, on the right.

For online maps and navigation, input 75 Falmouth Heights Road. ATTENTION: We have no off-site signs. The signs you may see are for another boat line.
