

The California Buildings, as the Museum of Man's structures are called, were completed in 1914, and officially opened in 1915 as part of the Panama-California Exposition. Architect Bertram Goodhue modeled them after Mexican and Spanish churches, although they have never been one: they have always been exhibit halls, except when they were used as a Navy hospital during World War II.
