



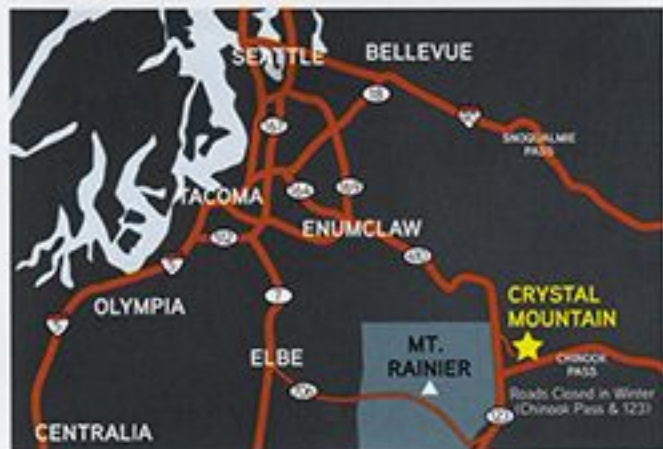

Getting to Crystal Mountain

Crystal Mountain is located on the northeast corner of Mt. Rainier National Park, just under 2 hours from Seattle, Tacoma & Bellevue. The town of Enumclaw is easily accessible via Highway 410, 164 or 169. From Enumclaw, drive 32 miles east up Highway 410. Turn left on Crystal Mountain Boulevard (after mile marker 57) and follow it for 6 miles to the resort. Distance: Seattle 76 miles, Bellevue 65 miles, Tacoma 64 miles and Olympia 84 miles.
