



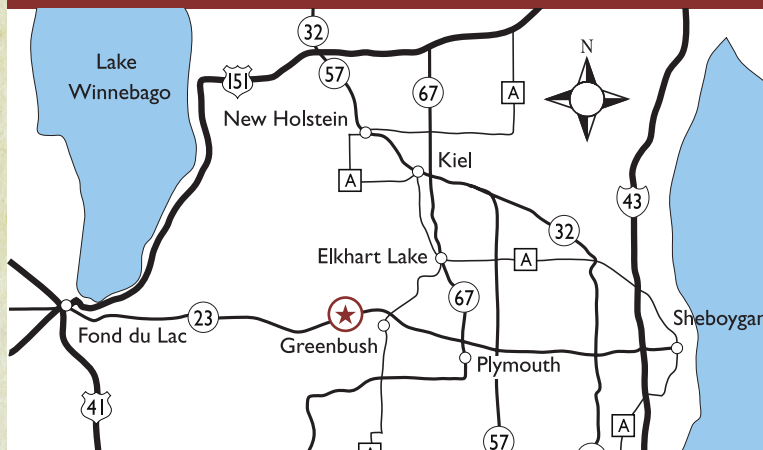
One of twelve historic sites and museums owned by the Wisconsin Historical Society, Wade House Historic Site is located just off Highway 23, halfway between Sheboygan and Fond du Lac. Set upon 240 rolling acres within the northern reaches of the Kettle Moraine State Forest, the site celebrates the world of plank road stagecoach travel, horse-drawn transportation, and mid-19th-century settlement and town building.

The new Wade House Visitor Center and Wesley W. Jung Carriage Museum provides orientation to the site and its themes. The wonder of Wisconsin's largest collection of carriages and wagons awaits each visitor to the state-of-the-art 20,000 square-foot carriage museum.

Visit Wade House's historic area to explore the era of stagecoach travel. Tour a stately 27-room stagecoach hotel, water-powered sawmill and blacksmith's workshop, as well as take an old-fashioned horse-drawn wagon ride.
