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SIX ITINERARIES FOR YOU



STOPOVER

- 1 A quick visit calls for a stroll down Main Street and Ark Row, then a bite at the classic Sam's Anchor Cafe — be sure to take in the terrific views from the deck.

PICNIC

- 2 Fill up your picnic basket at Woodlands Market and walk over to Shoreline Park to enjoy your lunch and espresso from Caffe Acri with a view of San Francisco.

DAY HOP

- 3 Ride the Paradise Loop, or hike the Tiburon Ridge Trail. See a 360-degree view at Old St. Hilary's Open Space Preserve. Then indulge in a meal at Tiburon Tavern or Lily Kai.

KIDS RULE

- 4 Take the kids to explore the Railroad & Ferry Depot Museum, followed by ice cream at the Grass Shack or pizza at Waypoint Pizza. Biking? Head to Blackie's Pasture.

OVERNIGHT

- 5 Start off at New Morning Café. Walk or ride The Old Rail Trail. Ferry to Angel Island. Enjoy pinot at Couloir Wines. Catch a movie at Tiburon Playhouse. Enjoy Italian at Luna Blu, Servino's, or Don Antonio. Retire at Waters Edge Hotel or The Lodge at Tiburon.

HOME BASE

- 6 From Tiburon it's a quick drive to Muir Woods, Stinson Beach, Point Reyes National Seashore, and Wine Country. Hop to San Francisco on the ferry, a short walk from upscale hotels like Waters Edge Hotel and The Lodge at Tiburon.

The Tiburon Peninsula is accessible by ferry, by bicycle, and by car via Highway 101 to Tiburon Boulevard.
