


Check in at Monterey Bay Whale Watch Center Monterey, CA



From San Jose and San Francisco (from North): Take Hwy 101 S, take Hwy 156 West (sign: Monterey Peninsula), take Hwy 1 S. Exit (sign: 402B Pacific Grove). This veers right into Del Monte Ave; Fisherman's Wharf is 1.5 miles on right. Park in gated lot (take ticket), drive forward. Walk down wharf (with shops and restaurants), near end, turn right and check in at Monterey Bay Whale Watch Center.

From Los Angeles (from South): Take Hwy 101 N, take Hwy 68 W, follow signs to Fisherman's Wharf and see above.
