Fishing options: Rainbow Trout, Steelhead, Atlantic Salmon and Pacific Salmon.

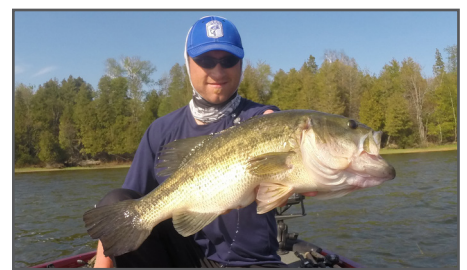
