## Directions

### From the Northeast Extension/Points North (I-476)

Travel on I-476 S toward Philadelphia. Take exit 18 toward Norristown. Merge onto W Ridge Pike and travel 1.3 miles. Turn right onto Fairfield Road. After .5 miles continue onto E Fomance Street. Travel 1.5 miles and turn right onto Harding Blvd. Zoo is entrance will be on the left.

### From the PA Turnpike/Points East (I-276)

Travel on I-276 W toward Harrisburg. Take exit 20 to merge onto I-476 S toward Philadelphia/Chester. After 1.7 miles take exit 18 toward Norristown. Merge onto W Ridge Pike and travel 1.3 miles. Turn right onto Fairfield Road. After .5 miles continue onto E Fomance Street. Travel 1.5 miles and turn right onto Harding Blvd. Zoo is entrance will be on the left.

### From the Blue Route/Points South (I-476)

Travel on I-476 N toward Plymouth Meeting. Take exit 18B toward Norristown. Merge onto Chemical Road, travel .1 miles and turn right onto W Ridge Pike. Travel 1.3 miles and turn right onto Fairfield Road. After .5 miles continue onto E Fomance Street. Travel 1.5 miles and turn right onto Harding Blvd. Zoo entrance will be on the left.

### From PA Turnpike/Points West (I-76)

Travel on I-76 E toward US-202/I-476/Philadelphia/Valley Forge. Take exit 328B to merge onto US-202 N toward King of Prussia. Travel 4.6 miles and turn left onto Harding Blvd. Travel .7 miles and turn into Zoo entrance on left.

### From Philadelphia (I-76)

Travel on I-76 W toward Valley Forge. Take exit 329 for South Henderson Road N/South Gulph Road toward King of Prussia/Norristown. Turn slight right onto S Henderson Road. Travel 1.4 miles and turn right onto E Dekalb Pike. After .5 miles Dekalb turns into US-202 N/Markley Street. Travel 1.8 miles and turn left onto Harding Blvd. Travel .7 miles and turn into Zoo entrance on left.
