## Guided Tours

## Campouts

Typically 2 or 3 nights, campouts are supported touring weekends that are based at a campground.

While all types of motorcycles are welcome, some campouts have a theme; such as, an introduction to adventure riding, romantic couples weekend, or attending events and rallies. The campgrounds where you will stay offer tent, cabin, or lodge accommodations. Rental motorcycles can be ridden from our location in Carnegie, PA or picked up at the campground. A chase vehicle will carry your gear, and guides will help you with routing or lead group rides.

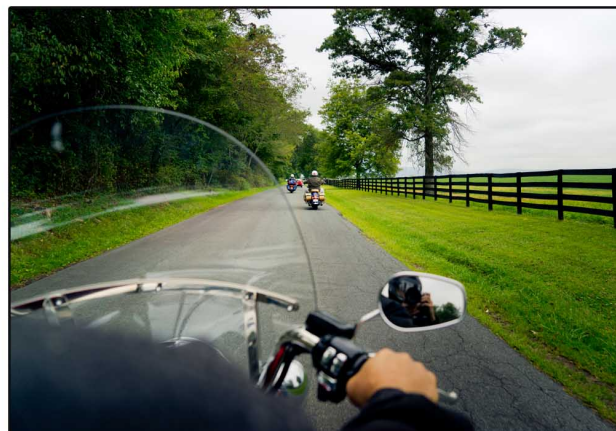

Harley lovers will surely love checking out this destination.

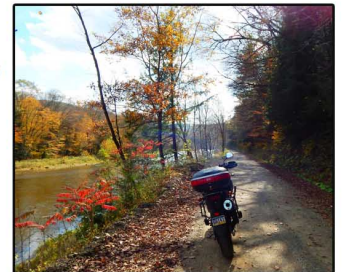


## Pennsylvania Woodlands Tour - 3 Days - 756 Miles

# Frequently Asked Questions

**Q:** What isn't included in my tour package?

**A:** Airfare, Fuel (fuel package may be purchased), Meals (except where specified), Entrance fees for unplanned activities.

**Q:** What happens if it rains?

**A:** Our first priority is the safety of our guests. While sometimes it may be impossible to avoid riding in a light rain, our guides will monitor the weather and suspend or re-route a tour to avoid hard rain or windy conditions. Guests should bring rain gear designed for motorcycling.



**Q:** Can I ride my own bike on a guided tour?

**A:** Yes! Once the minimum amount of rental tourists has been met, we will open a limited amount of spots for non-renters, giving priority to family and friends of rental customers.



**Q:** What if I get lost?

**A:** Don't worry! With all the tools we provide, it's highly unlikely you will get lost. If you do, our free routing concierge service is only a phone call away.

**Q:** Do I have to sleep on the ground to attend a campout?

**A:** No, absolutely not! The campgrounds where we stay have multiple ways to accommodate our guests ranging from tents, to cabins, to lodges. Even tent campers get a thick air mattress!



**Q:** What if I break down?

**A:** The chase vehicle for guided tours carries a spare motorcycle, so that we can immediately provide a replacement bike. If the bike is not a suitable replacement for you, it may take a day, but we will get a new bike to you as fast as we can. You will be reimbursed for any days lost. On self-guided tours, the waiver option chosen will dictate the level of service provided.

**Q:** What if I want to end my tour at a different location?

**A:** You can do that! Standard EagleRider one-way fees apply.



**Q:** Can a tour be modified to see a point of interest that isn't on the itinerary?

**A:** Yes! There are so many things to see along the way that we can't possibly stop at them all. If you have your heart set on a special point of interest, we'll do our best to get you there!
