Gallery activities, exploration tables and drop-in art making are designed for adults and kids to enjoy together.



Explore Carnegie Science Center's four floors of hands-on exhibits, including SpacePlace, a weightlessness simulation Highmark SportsWorks®, roboworld® and the Robot Hall of Fame, authentic Cold War submarine, laser shows and the one-of-a-kind Miniature Railroad & Village®.

Kennywood Park is America's finest traditional amusement park. This 118-year-old National Historic Landmark is the only park to have three rides designated as a "Coaster Landmark" by the American Coaster Enthusiasts. Be sure to check out the eye-popping adventure of the 4-D Theater! Don't leave without trying the Potato Patch fries!



Scale the slopes of Mt. Washington on the **Duquesne Incline** in cable cars running since 1877. Soak in the panoramic view of Pittsburgh. Watch the original hoisting equipment from the machine room viewing platform. At the top, see historic photos of the city and pick up souvenirs at the Welcome Center. It's FUN-icular!




Discover more than 250 years of Pittsburgh history at the **Senator John Heinz History Center**, an affiliate of the Smithsonian Institution. Experience the magic of *Mister Rogers' Neighborhood* and see the largest collection of original items on display from the show's set—including King Friday's Castle and the home of X The Owl. Enjoy the *Heinz Company* exhibition featuring the story behind the 57 varieties and the condiment king's original ketchup recipe.



Don't miss Daniel Tiger's Neighborhood: A Grr-iffic Exhibit at **Children's Museum of Pittsburgh**. After a stroll through the Rain Meander, create water fountains, channels and dams in Waterplay. Use real tools and cutting-edge digital media to build, tinker and make exciting projects in $MAKESHOP^{\otimes}$. You can even ink your own silkscreen in the Studio.







Flock to the **National Aviary**, America's premier bird zoo! Get nose-to-beak with 500 birds representing 150 species from around the world. At *Penguins Point*, get a 360-degree view of African penguins. Watch Malayan Flying Foxes at *Canary's Call* and take part in the free-flight bird shows inside *Immersion Theater* or outside in the historic rose garden, weather permitting.



Inspire little explorers with a trip to **Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Gardens**. It's a special place where kids can unearth the wonders of nature. Bring the whole family for a fun adventure in the *Children's Discovery Garden* and *Butterfly Forest*, and learn about everything from bugs to botany as you play.







Every visit is a wild adventure at the **Pittsburgh Zoo & PPG Aquarium**, one of only six major zoo and aquarium combos in the country. It's home to 4,000 animals, including tigers, giraffes, rhinos, elephants and primates from all parts of the globe. The zoo's *Kids' Kingdom* is among the best kids' zoos in the nation. *The Islands*, features cascading waterfalls, ponds and endangered animals.
