FREE ADMISSION: The South Gates will open at 8 a.m. Anyone donating non-perishable food items by 11 a.m. (at the South Gate), will receive free admission to the festival. Patrons are welcome to attend the Liturgy for Peace and Justice beginning at 9:30 a.m. and receive free admission to the festival immediately following. Those donating food who choose not to attend the service will receive a hand stamp valid for free entry at any time that day during regular festival hours (11 a.m. to 10 p.m.). All non-perishable food will be donated to Hunger Task Force.

COLLEGE DAY: \$3 discount off admission 2 p.m. to 7 p.m. with valid college student ID (all gates).

MILITARY/VETERANS DAY: Free admission (+1 guest) with valid military ID (all gates).
