

PARKING: Clipper Navigation, Inc. does not manage parking facilities & take responsibility for vehicles or contents. Limited long-term paid parking is available near the terminal.

PASSENGER CONDUCT: Clipper Navigation, Inc. reserves the right to refuse passage to any person in the interest of the safety and comfort of our passengers, and reserves the right to refuse service of alcoholic beverages to any person.

CLIPPER'S RESPONSIBILITY: Transportation of passenger luggage is provided by Clipper Navigation, Inc. and is governed by the "Terms and Conditions" available at Clipper Vacations.

The San Juan Islands are located in the U.S. and do not require a passport for travel from Seattle.

IMMIGRATION BETWEEN U.S. & CANADA: U.S. regulations on restricted items are available in literature on board the vessel or at Clipper terminals.

CANADA CUSTOMS: Restricted and Prohibited Weapons: All automatic weapons, handguns, revolvers, pepper spray, bombs mentioned are illegal. Please contact Canada Customs for further information and for information on importation of regulated firearms.

IMMIGRATION: Identification is necessary to Customs and Border Protection. Due to tightened security at the United States borders, border crossing, all travelers must present a Passport, Passport Card or Enhanced Driver's License (EDL) at sea and land borders. See www.ClipperVacations.com for more details and information including requirements for children. Currently EDLs are available in many states, including Washington. Check with your local DOB for more information or visit our website.

Children traveling without both parents need to provide documentation from the child's parent or proof of custody. If you are entering the United States or Canada from either, you will be required to have a passport and provide a visa.

DRINKING & DRIVING: Persons with a felony may be denied entrance into Canada. Canadian law defines Driving While Intoxicated or Driving Under the Influence as follows:
