- Carolyn & James Millar Presidential Gallery:** Original one-page signed letters and an image of each President.

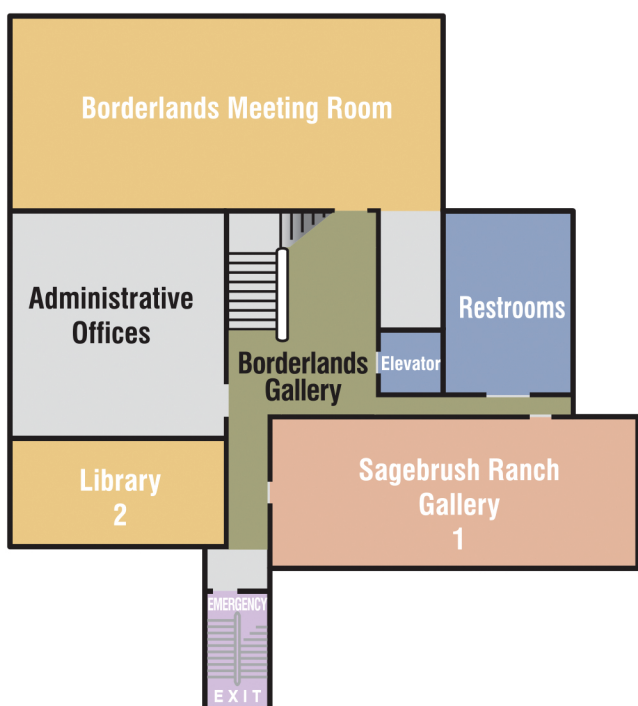
Main Level
