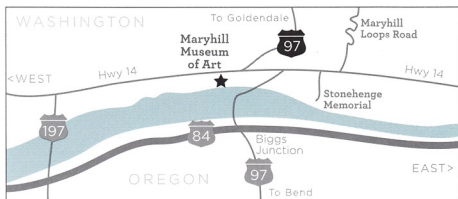

Maryhill Museum of Art is one of the Northwest's most fascinating cultural destinations. Exhibitions include a gallery of works by Auguste Rodin, European and American paintings, objets d'art from the palaces of Queen Marie of Romania, Orthodox icons, unique international chess sets and the haute couture miniatures of the *Théâtre de la Mode*. The Native American collection includes objects from prehistoric through contemporary. Family activities, outdoor sculpture garden, café and Museum Store on site. Stonehenge Memorial and the historic Maryhill Loops Road nearby.
