HANGAR TOUR

- We strongly advise you to visit our Theater at the beginning of your tour. Here you will learn about the history of the hangar and the aircraft in Hangar B.
- The Exhibit Hall has rare wartime naviation themed artifacts, photos representing the era of lighter-than-air ships, hangar construction and World War II.
- As you come onto the hangar floor, please watch your step as the hangar flooring is uneven and the lighting is dim. You are free to roam anywhere you wish. We recommend you make your way around the planes and visit our aircraft engine and military vehicle display.
- Throughout the hangar you will find aircraft representing vintage to modern technology. Read about the aircraft history from the information plaques.
- Get into an aircraft trainer and enjoy the feeling of what it must have been like to pilot a high performance aircraft!
- Helium for the blimps in World War II was once transferred from here. See some of the machinery that made this possible.

FACTS ABOUT HANGAR B

Length - 1,072 feet

Height - 192 feet (over 15 stories)

Width - 296 feet

Area - Over 7 acres (enough to play six football games!)

Doors - 120 feet high, 6 sections each weighing 30 tons (180 tons total).

220 foot wide opening. The sections roll on railroad tracks.

Catwalks - Two catwalks, each 137 feet above the hangar deck.
