ACCESSIBILITY

The entrance to the Piano Pavilion is accessible through the underground parking garage and from the group drop-off on Camp Bowie Boulevard. The entrance to the Kahn Building is accessible through the Kahn east entrance. Reserved handicapped parking spaces are available in the underground parking garage, the Kahn Building east visitor parking lot, and the Darnell Street parking lot. A Special Assistance Vehicle (SAV) is available for visitors with mobility challenges who would like assistance in traveling from one building to the other. Visit the information desk in either building to request the SAV.

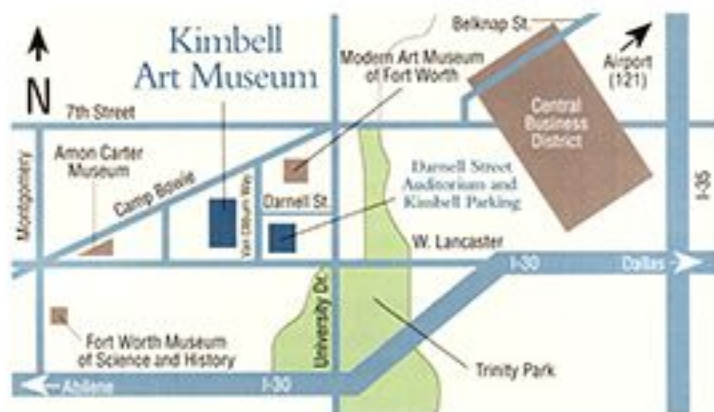
