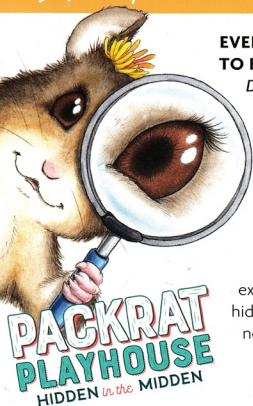
**Nestled within the lushest desert on Earth,

This indoor (air-conditioned) play
space allows children to discover
the desert through the eyes of this
curious critter. Kids can slide down
a Gila monster's tail, climb through
prickly pear cactus pads, slither
through an oversized rattlesnake,
explore secret tunnels, stumble upon
hidden objects, scramble in giant rope
netting, and much more! Parents can
enjoy snacks and beverages while
their little packrats run, jump, play,
learn, and interact.

DON'T MISS RAPTOR FREE FLIGHT!!!

Stand in the flight path as native birds-of-prey fly so close you can feel the brush of feathers.

(Seasonal: Mid-October through late March)

Get "buzzed" by diverse species of hummingbirds in the walk-through aviary.

Witness courtship, nesting, and chick-fledging January through May. Then explore the Earth Sciences' limestone cave to see stunning gems and minerals found in the region.
