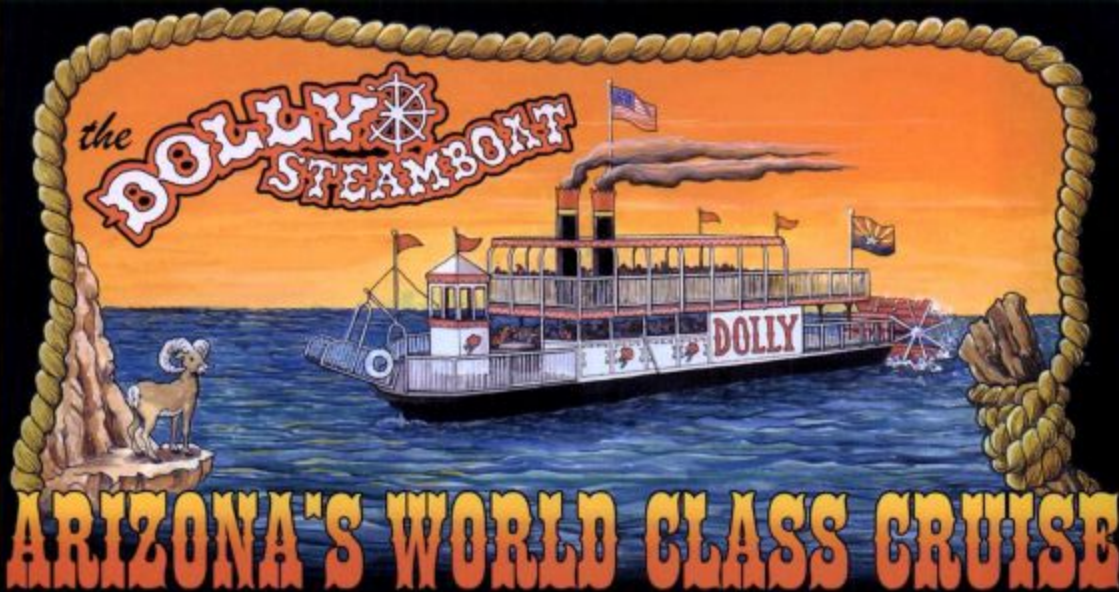

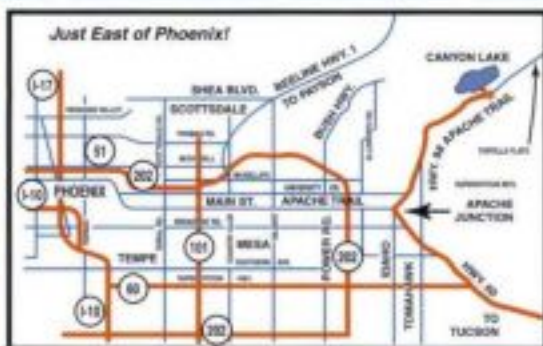

Highway 60 to Apache Junction, turn north on Idaho to Hwy 88 (Apache Trail), travel 1.6 miles NE on the paved historic Apache Trail. Just past the second one lane bridge, turn left
