ST. LOUIS CEMETERY NO. 1

Founded in 1789 and listed on the National Register of Historic Places, St. Louis Cemetery No. 1 is the oldest existing cemetery in the city.

Notable structures include the famed oven wall vaults, the rumored final resting place of Voodoo Queen Marie Laveau, and the magnificent tombs of the French, Italian, Portuguese, and Spanish societies.

The cemetery tour will lead you through a maze of family, military, and society tombs, as you learn about the integrated society of early New Orleans, and the unique burial practices in the "Cities of the Dead."

LAFAYETTE CEMETERY NO. 1

Lafayette Cemetery No. 1, located in the historic Garden District, was founded in 1833 and has been in continuous use ever since.

Placed on the National Register of Historic Places by virtue of its significant history, location, and architectural importance, it retains its original configuration of intersecting, tree-lined avenues designed to accommodate funeral processions.

On the tour, you will stroll through the organized rows of family and society tombs while your guide points out the final resting places of the real heroes and fictional villains who reside in the cemetery.
