Turn left on South McDonough Street. As you walk past Agnes Scott College (on your right) you'll see why it's regularly listed as one of the loveliest college campuses in the U.S.



McCain Arch, named for the second president of Agnes Scott. Through the east window you'll see a magnificent American beech tree. Use the pedestrian tunnel opposite the arch to

Turn right on College Avenue and pop into the


cross under the railroad track. Continue straight and stroll down Church Street - take a peek at Revival; go past Twain's

Brewpub & Billiards - pop around the corner to see the Living Walls mural! Continue on Church Street, past the MARTA station

at Sycamore Street. Take a left on East Ponce de Leon Avenue towards the square - find sculptures, murals, and **Decatur's Secret Doors** as well as cafés, restaurants, galleries, and boutiques. Knocking around the square can earn another 500 steps!







on Clairemont Avenue, and browse the exhibit in the Decatur Arts Alliance gallery. And guess what! You're halfway there (5,000 steps)! Continue west on Ponce de Leon Avenue, past the



Old Courthouse on the Square. Enjoy Souper Jenny for lunch – especially if it's a sunny day. Head down West Ponce de Leon Avenue.

Listen in at **Decatur CD** and you may catch an up-close-and-personal in-store performance.

Refuel at Kale Me Crazy. Or Chai Pani. Or Taqueria del Sol. Or Farmburger. So many choices







Street. Find Adair Park - there's even a pooch-friendly area down the hill. Stay on Adair Street until you reach West Howard turn left to find Treehouse Kid & Craft.

Head back on West Howard Avenue toward

the pedestrian crossing at Atlanta Avenue. Cross West Howard Avenue, the railroad tracks, and College Avenue safely.

Turn right on West College Avenue; take a left on Mead Road at the corner by The Imperial.

Pass Oakhurst Elementary School and return to Oakhurst Village to complete 10,000 steps. Rest your feet on a bench in the newly renovated

Harmony Park. Grab a bite at a great local

restaurant, like Universal Joint - you've earned it! Yea!)
