Home and Museum: 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Saturday, noon-5 p.m. Sunday and most federal holidays. Hours on July 4 are 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Research Library: 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Saturday. Closed Sunday and holidays.

All facilities are closed on Mondays from January through March (except Presidents' Day) and on Easter, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day.

Admission to the research library and the tomb, grounds and trails is FREE. The grounds are open every day from dawn until dusk.
