Directions to Hyannis

From New York City: *Approximately 270 miles*
Follow Route 95 to Providence, RI; Route 195 to Wareham, MA; Route 25 to Bourne Bridge; Route 6 to Exit #6; Route 132 into Hyannis. Follow signs to airport or docks. Approximately 4-5 hours, depending on traffic.

From Boston: *Approximately 80 miles*
Follow Route 3 (Southeast Expressway); Route 6 over the Sagamore Bridge; Route 132 into Hyannis; follow signs to airport or docks. Approximately 1.5 hours, depending on traffic.

Public Transportation

Beginning April 27, 2018 the Nantucket Regional Transit Authority, called The WAVE, will enter a new phase in the history of transportation on the Island by offering year-round service.

Year Round Service will operate April 27-May 13, and will continue service after Columbus Day on the Mid-Island Loop, Miacomet Loop, and along Old South Road and Nobadeer Farm Road with morning and afternoon trips continuing on to Sconset. Weekday service will operate 7am-9pm. Weekend service will operate 7am-7pm. Additional hours of service will be provided for: Daffodil Weekend, Stroll Weekend and New Year's Eve.

Summer Service will operate May 14-October 8. Hours of service and frequency vary depending on route. The Mid-Island Loop, Miacomet Loop, and Sconset via Old South Road Route operates daily from 7:00am-11:30pm. Mid-June to Labor Day service will be provided until midnight. Service is provided daily mid-June through Labor Day on the Sconset via Milestone Road Route from 7:15am-7:15pm. Service is provided daily mid-June thru Labor Day 10:00am-6:00pm on the Jetties and Surfside Beach Routes, Airport Route, Sconset via Milestone Road Route, and Sconset via Polpis Road Route.

General Information: Fares: \$2.00 – Mid Island Loop, Miacomet Loop, and Jetties Beach Route; \$3.00 – Sconset Routes, Madaket Route, Airport Route, and Surfside Beach Route. Half Fare: Seniors 65 and older, persons with disabilities, veterans and active military personnel. Children 6 and under ride free.

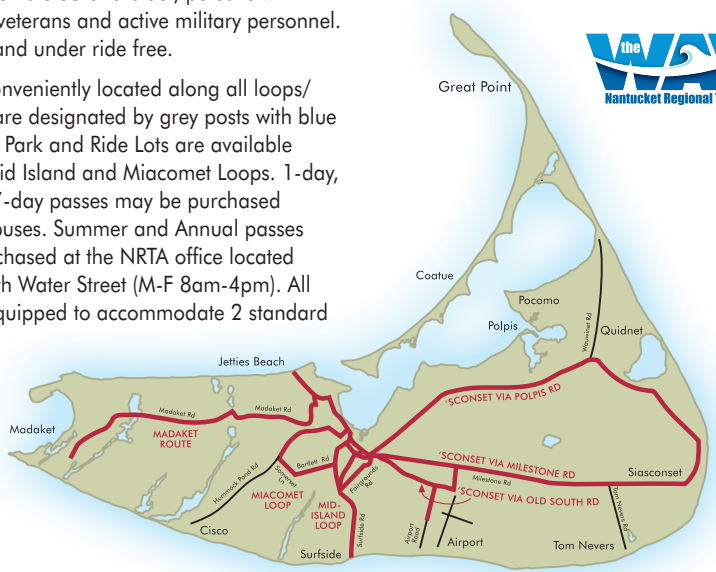
Stops are conveniently located along all loops/routes and are designated by grey posts with blue stripes. Free Park and Ride Lots are available along the Mid Island and Miacomet Loops. 1-day, 3-day and 7-day passes may be purchased aboard all buses. Summer and Annual passes may be purchased at the NRTA office located at 20 R South Water Street (M-F 8am-4pm). All buses are equipped to accommodate 2 standard

bicycles on a first come first serve basis. All buses are accessible to persons with disabilities. Your Island Ride provides ADA complementary paratransit service. To schedule a ride, call 508-325-7516.

To speak to a dispatcher, call Monday through Friday 8am-4pm. Pets and trained service animals are permitted aboard all vehicles, but must be under control of the passenger at all times. To make a request for modifications to current service procedures, access the service call at 508-325-7516 at least the day before the trip; additional fees will not be charged.
