WHAT TO EXPECT

Museum Admission

Explore the beautifully designed Museum at your own pace, with 3 exhibition spaces, a Learning Center, and beautiful facilities. MOCA's core exhibition, With a Single Step: Stories in the Making of America, presents the diverse layers of the Chinese American experience, while examining America's journey as a nation of immigrants.

Museum Highlights Tour

This tour highlights the major themes of MOCA's core exhibition, With a Single Step: Stories in the Making of America, and explores more of Presidental Medal of Freedom recipient Maya Lin's design of the museum and our unique historical content. Tour Length: approx. 45 minutes.

Chinatown Walking Tour

This historic tour helps to "demystify" the neighborhood and discover one of the most important immigrant hubs of New York City, which began as a Native American village before evolving from Five Points into the present day Chinatown. *Tour Length: approx. 75 minutes*.

Chinatown Food Tour

Taste the diverse food and cooking styles of Chinese cuisine which showcase the unexpectedy diverse culture of the neighborhood. This delicious tour includes 2-3 samples from famous local hotspots and "off the beaten path" locations that are sure to delight! *Tour Length: approx. 90 minutes.*
