7 Lifts: 1 Quad, 1 Triple, 2 Doubles, 3 Wonder Carpets
 Terrain: 36 trails and 133 skiable acres!
 Vertical Descent: 1000 ft
 Longest Run: Ridge Run to Upper and Lower Promenade - 2 miles

These symbols indicate the relative degree of difficulty of a particular slope or trail compared with all other trails at Catamount. If you are unfamiliar with this ski area you should transition through various degrees of difficulty beginning with the trails marked "Easier." If you are unable to ski or snowboard down the mountain for any reason please seek assistance from a lift attendant or ski patrol.
