BREAKFAST /
Chicken & Waffles
with a Korean twist
at **La Foret**. (SW)



» Step back into the 1920's as you explore the period village at **Burnaby Village Museum**, including costumed townsfolk, blacksmith's forge, and Burnaby's interurban 1223 tram. At the end of your visit, take a ride on the working vintage 1912 carousel. (SW)

LUNCH / Enjoy an award-winning samosa at **Safari Snack House**, offering a fusion of East African and Indian cuisine. (SW)

» Experience the sunset over **Deer Lake**. Rent a single or double kayak and paddle out on to the lake for a spectacular sunset view. You'll forget you're in the city on this peaceful, family-friendly lake. (SW)

DINNER / Walk through **Little Vietnam** and stop in for an authentic Korean meal. (NE)

Visit **Dageraad Brewing**, a small-batch artisan brewery specializing in authentic Belgian beers. You might try a Burnabarian, their easy-drinking Belgian Table Beer that shows a little love to its hometown. (SW)

Eat

Anton's Pasta is a local legend. Devour its Sicilian-style dishes including the Risotto Alla Creola. An unforgettable experience.

The Pear Tree restaurant is a place where culturally inspired foods top the charts. Try the gourmet pan-roasted Haida Gwaii Halibut.

The **Glenburn Soda Fountain** is perfect for satisfying a sweet tooth. The menu is well known for its fizzy sodas made using a 1931 Walrus Soda Fountain.

From historic **Hart House Restaurant's** upscale dining to casual bites at **Anatolia's Gate**, everyone will feel satisfied.

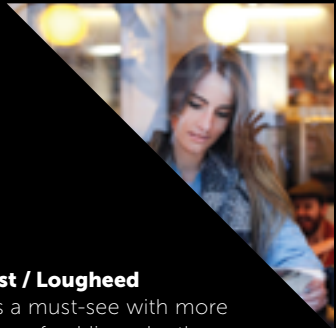
Get Outside
