show you some captivating views of this iconic symbol of America.



Your tour guide will provide an in-depth overview of the town's historical facts, and show you the beauty of cobblestoned streets lined with historic buildings, and visit **Christ Church**, the place where both George Washington and Robert E. Lee had regularly attended services.

After exploring Old Town Alexandria, we will depart for **George Washington's Mount Vernon**. The 10-mile journey to George Washington's estate will take you along the scenic **Potomac River**, where you will learn the importance it had during the era along with viewing sites such as the **200-year-old Fort Washington**.

Arlington National Cemetery is located on a 600-acre parcel of land that once belonged to George Washington's stepgrandson, George Washington Parke Custis.

In 1857, Custis left the property to his daughter Mary Anna Randolph Custis, where it became the family home for her and her husband, Robert E. Lee.

Your adventure begins when we depart the Nation's Capital for our **Old Town Alexandria and Mount Vernon Tour**, where you will explore the Old Town Alexandria, which dates back to the 1700s, and entrance into George Washington's Mount Vernon. Full tour description of our Old Town Alexandria and Mount Vernon Tour provided on the next page to the right.

After exploring the grounds of George Washington's Mount Vernon, we will start the journey towards the hallowed ground of **Arlington National Cemetery**. Since its first military burial on May 13, 1864, Arlington National Cemetery has become the final resting place for more than 400,000 active duty service members, veterans, and their families. Gray Line's National Arlington Cemetery Tour includes entrance and an interpretative tour of the grounds with stops near the **Kennedy gravesites** and **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier**, where you can observe the changing of the quard ceremony.

Arlington National Cemetery is an enduring tribute to those who've dedicated their lives to defending the ideals of our nation. A visit here will leave an indelible impression on your spirit.
