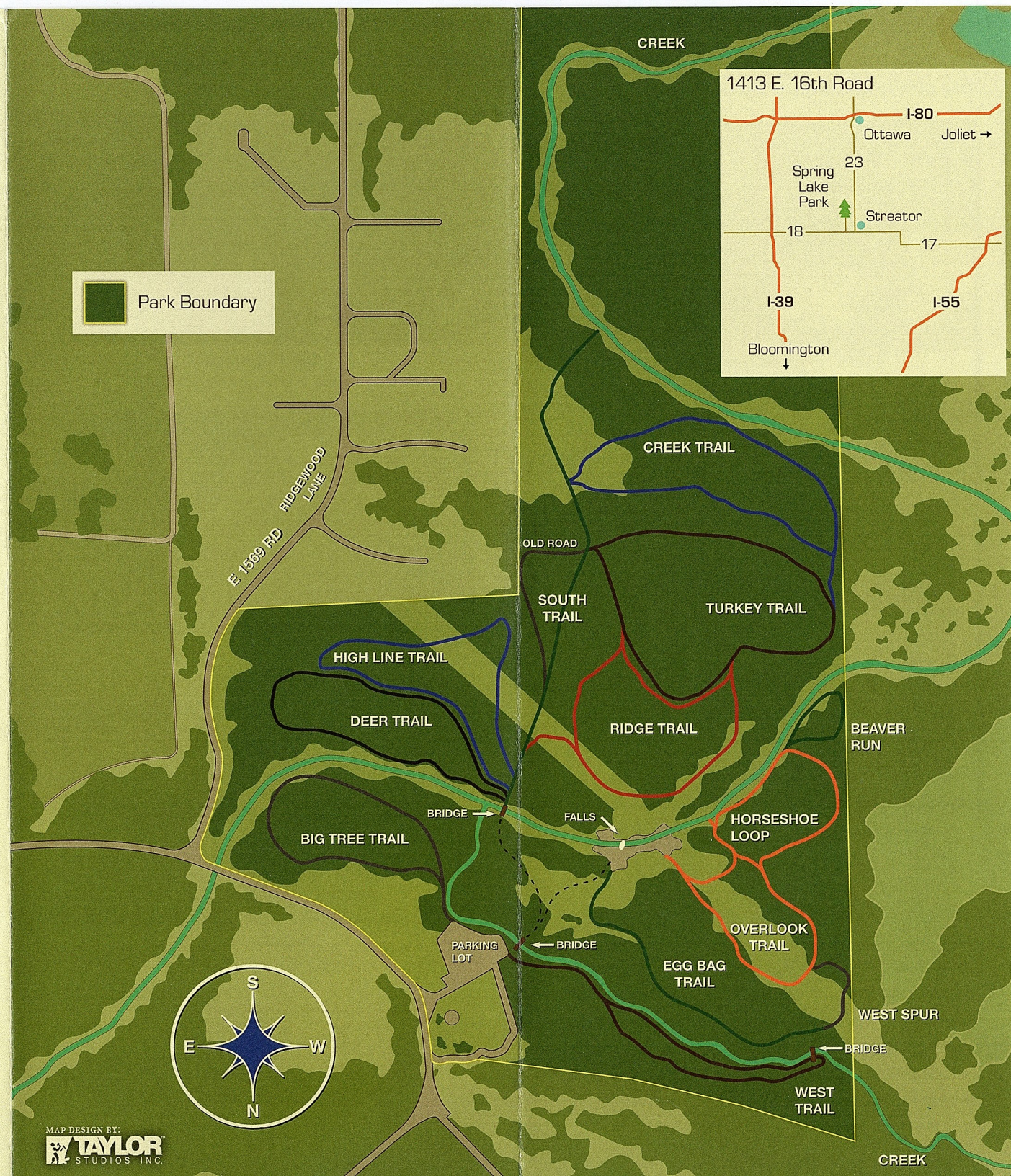
Please help keep the park clean and safe by following City of Streator ordinances and Illinois state law:

- No motorized vehicles
- No alcohol
- No swimming
- No hunting or firearms
- No dumping of trash
- No loud music or boisterous activity
- No solicitation or selling of merchandise
- Groups of 25 or more must be reported in advance to the City Clerk's office
- Dogs must be leashed at all times

Explore the Trails!

- You can explore twelve different trails, most a half mile or less in length.
- Hikers, bikers, and horses share the same trails. Caution is advised when meeting; horses are easily startled.
- Please stay on the trails and be alert to changing conditions, such as fallen tree limbs, poison ivy, and wet soil.
