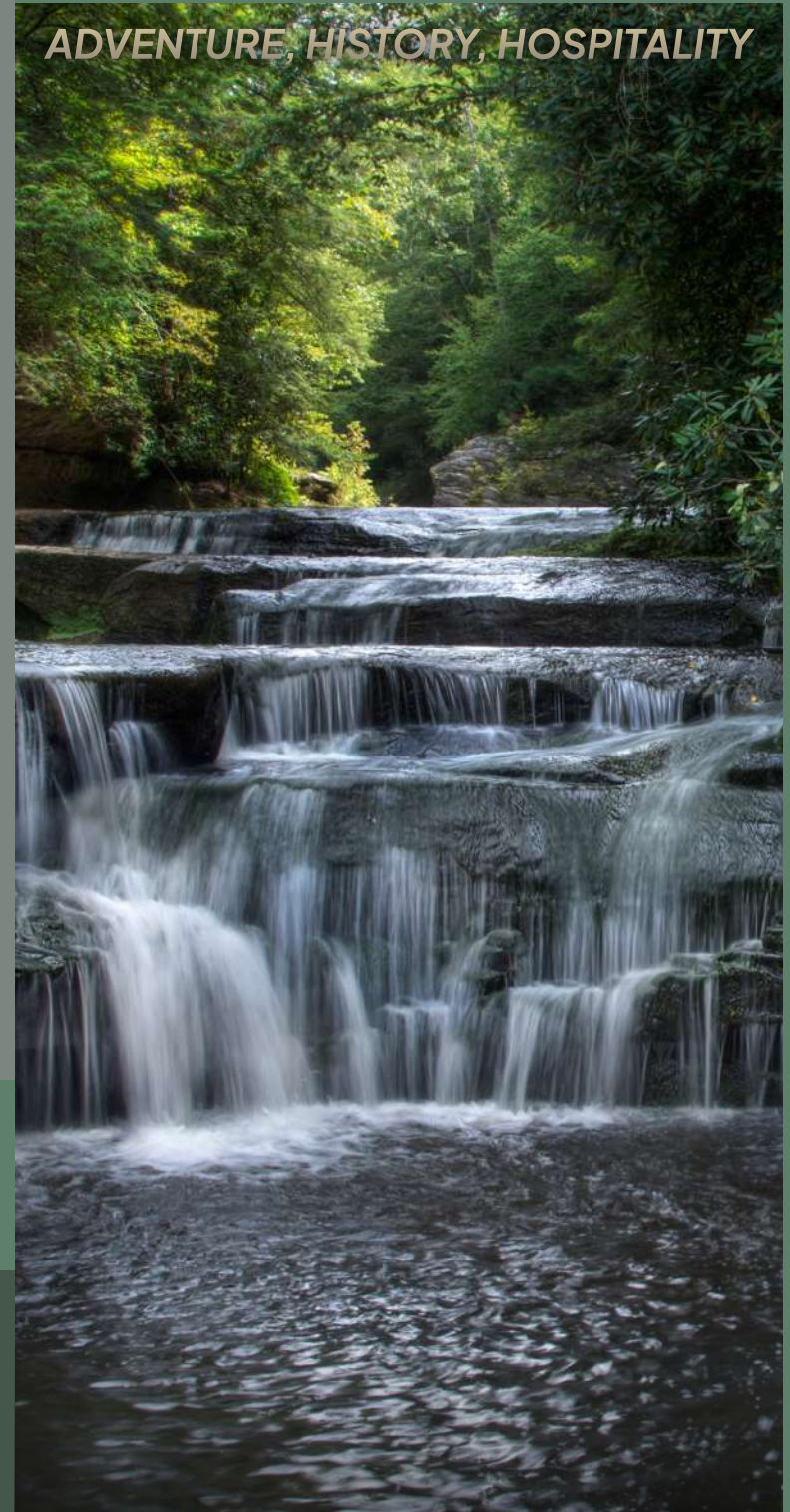

## Cumberland Falls

Called the "Niagara of the south", established on August 21, 1931, geologists estimate that the rock over which the Cumberland River plunges is about 250 million years old. The 125 foot wide falls drops 88 feet into the Cumberland River and, under the light of the full moon, offers one of the only two "Moonbows" in the entire world. The park also includes hiking trails, gem mining, special programs, fishing, swimming, boating, playgrounds, picnicking and more!
