

More fun, more affordable - it all starts at King Pine.

First-timers and families love our friendly, knowledgeable ski school and easy, gentle learning terrain, while more advanced skiers and snowboarders can explore our terrain park, steeper trails, and tree-skiing areas. King Pine also offers night skiing, lift-serviced snowtubing, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, ice-skating, family events, and après ski fun.

Owned and operated by generations of the Hoyt Family since the late 1800s, Purity Spring Resort has been providing hospitality and the rich tradition of family-oriented recreational activities for over 100 years. In 1938, a rope tow was installed and Milt Hoyt brought small groups of guests to the Inn to enjoy the relatively new sport of snow skiing. The Ski & Snowboard Camp for boys and girls was started in 1939 and is known as the longest-running ski camp in the country. King Pine Ski Area opened in 1962. Today, with a network of well-maintained surface and chairlifts, quality snowmaking, and a reputation of being 100% open, family fun remains the soul of King Pine and a winter tradition for you to discover.




