Historic Train Station

Our fully restored 1903 Lenox Train Station is a historic museum recognized on the National Register of Historic Places. We offer a unique glimpse into railroad history and showcase a large collection of railroad artifacts and exhibits including diesel locomotives, cabooses, and passenger cars. Visitors can relive rail history on our guided walking tour around the vard and "block house" or for a small donation can take a quick locomotive cab ride on our "Jitney" vard service train. Admission to the Museum is free but donations for operations and ongoing repairs are requested and always appreciated! The Museum and the Hoosac Valley Train Service are separate operations but are both owned and operated by Berkshire Scenic Railway Museum, Inc. We are a non-profit, volunteer-run organization since 1984.

From the Massachusetts Turnpike Exit 2 (Lee): Take Route 20 west 4.5 miles (through downtown Lee) to the Housatonic Street traffic light in Lenox. Make a right hand turn onto Housatonic Street and follow for 1.3 miles then turn left onto Willow Creek Road.

From Pittsfield and Points North: Travel south on Routes 7 & 20 to the Housatonic Street traffic light in Lenox. Make a left hand turn onto Housatonic Street and follow for 1.3 miles then turn left onto Willow Creek Road.

From the East: Follow Route 2 West into downtown North Adams. Take left onto Eagle Street. At light, go straight across Main Street, onto Ashland Street take immediate right after American Legion Drive onto Crowley Ave.

From the West: Follow Route 2 East into downtown North Adams, taking a slight right onto West Main Street. After Holiday Inn, turn right onto American Legion Drive, enter driveway after Brien Center to Crowley Ave.

From the Massachusetts Turnpike Exit 2 (Lee): Take Route 20 west (through downtown Lee) about 11.2 miles to the center of Pittsfield. Turn right onto East Street (State Route 9 east) and follow for 3.2 miles to the traffic light at Dalton Ave. Continue straight onto State Route 8 north (Cheshire Road) and follow for 17.8 miles to North Adams. Turn right at the traffic light onto Main Street. After Holiday Inn, turn right onto American Legion Drive. After the Brien Center, turn right onto Crowley Ave.
