HISTORY & HEROES AT THE JERSEY CAPE





WORLD WAR II LOOKOUT TOWER Located on Sunset Blvd. in Cape May it was part of coastal defenses during World War II, this 100 ft. tower built in 1942 is the last lookout tower remaining on the southern New Jersey coast. For a small fee, visitors can climb a staircase where Observers answer questions and can view displays and exhibits honoring veterans.

VIETNAM VETERANS MEMORIAL WALL The only permanent Vietnam Memorial replica in the Northeast, is an exact, half-size, black granite replica of the official Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C. It has the 58,913 names of our country's fallen heroes from the Vietnam War etched on its panels and stretches for 240 feet along the sidewalk of Columbus Park in Wildwood, NJ.

NAVAL AIR STATION WILDWOOD (NASW) AVIATION MUSEUM

is at the Cape May Airport inside a real World War II hangar. NASW was a former Naval base, that was used during the war to train dive bomber pilots from 1943 to 1945. The museum that houses a number of aircraft, engines, special exhibits, and educational interactive displays. A great activity for a rainy day or to get out of the sun.

THE TATHAM LIFE SAVING STATION AND MUSEUM Located at Second Ave. and 117th St., the Stephen C. Ludlam American Legion Post 331 has diligently preserved this former Life Saving Station built in 1895 and is the oldest





building in Stone Harbor. Free guided tours of the Life-Saving Museum and Military Memorabilia Museum are offered from Flag Day in June thru Labor Day.

U.S LIFE SAVING STATION 30 - OCEAN CITY The Station Museum located at 4th Street and Atlantic Ave. dates to 1885 and was home to those who rescued passengers and crew from the shipwrecks that occurred during that time. It includes a boat room, kitchen, living quarters and station office. Come experience how these brave surfmen responded to the shipwrecks and people in need along the shore.





PARKS & REC AT THE JERSEY CAPE





CORSON'S INLET STATE PARK This 341-acre undeveloped tract of land at the south end of Ocean City is home to a natural habitat rich in diverse wildlife. The park offers outstanding scenic beauty and is a great place for hiking, fishing, crabbing, boating and sunbathing. Facilities and activities include a boat ramp, hiking trails, saltwater fishing and crabbing.

BELLEPLAIN STATE FOREST Located in Woodbine at the Northwest corner of the Jersey Cape, the forest offers over forty miles of trails for hiking, biking and horseback riding. Other activities include hunting, fishing, swimming at Lake Nummy and a variety of camping options. Belleplain is a well-known birding spot, especially during the spring migration.

CAPE MAY POINT STATE PARK With 244 acres of freshwater meadows, forests, dunes and beach, it's one of the best sites for bird watching in North America and a natural route for migratory birds. Known for the Cape May Lighthouse, a World War II gun battery and fire control tower, the park offers beach walking, hiking, fishing and picnicking.

HEREFORD LIGHTHOUSE Built in 1874 in North Wildwood, this historic structure is open to the public and still functions as an active navigational aid. Visitors to the Lighthouse learn about its rich history and the Lighthouse grounds are a great place for a relaxing stroll in the gardens and a place to enjoy the beauty of the seashore.





CAPE MAY LIGHTHOUSE Built in 1859 and still an aid to navigation, visitors can climb the 199 steps to the top of the lighthouse for a spectacular panoramic view of the Atlantic Ocean and Delaware Bay for a fee. For those who choose not to climb, there's a fully-accessible visitors center, Museum Shop and beautiful grounds to explore.
