#### THE CHERRY TREES

The blossoming cherry trees planted throughout Philadelphia's Fairmount Park symbolize the city's friendship with Japan. In 1926, about 1,600 trees were planted in the park as a gift from the Japanese government and a tribute to the American Sesquicentennial. Since 1998, Japan America Society of Greater Philadelphia has overseen planting more than 1,000 additional trees.

#### TREE PLANTING INITIATIVE

Beginning in 2023, and with the special sponsorship of Philadelphia Insurance Companies, Japan America Society of Greater Philadelphia will plant an additional 250 trees over the next three years to commemorate America's Semiquincentennial (250th) anniversary.
