About Shofuso Japanese House and Garden

Shofuso Japanese House and Garden is a traditional-style Japanese house and garden in Philadelphia's West Fairmount Park. Shofuso was built in Japan in 1953 using ancient techniques and materials and exhibited in the courtyard at the Museum of Modern Art in New York, then moved to Philadelphia in 1958.



A viewing garden with koi pond and island, a tea garden (ryoji) and a courtyard garden comprise the nationally-ranked 17th century-style Japanese walled and fenced garden of this historic site and museum.

Shofuso is open to the public for visitation weekends in April and October, and Wednesday through Sunday from May through September.
