Etiquette

- Please keep all 4 tires of the Golf Car on the path around the Tees, Greens, and Par 3's.
- Please fill all divots with sand from Golf Car and smooth over with foot.
- Please repair all Ball Marks and one other on the putting green.
- Please rake all bunkers.
- · Allow faster players to play through.
- If you have a Handicap Flag you may drive 30 feet from the green, but please keep all 4 tires on the path around the tees and on the Par 3's.

USGA Rules govern all play except where modified by Local Rules

Local Rules

- All white stakes, white fences, and inner edge of the roadways are Out of Bounds.
- All red stakes, hedges, and canals are considered Lateral Water Hazards.
- 150 yardage markers are movable obstructions.
- If a ball strikes an elevated power line or cable, the stroke is canceled and the player must play a ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played.
- The Environmentally-Sensitive Area to the right of Gold #3 and right of Gold #7 are to be played as Lateral Water Hazards. Entry into or play out of these areas are Prohibited.
- If a Staked Tree interferes with a player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2b. (Immovable Obstruction)
