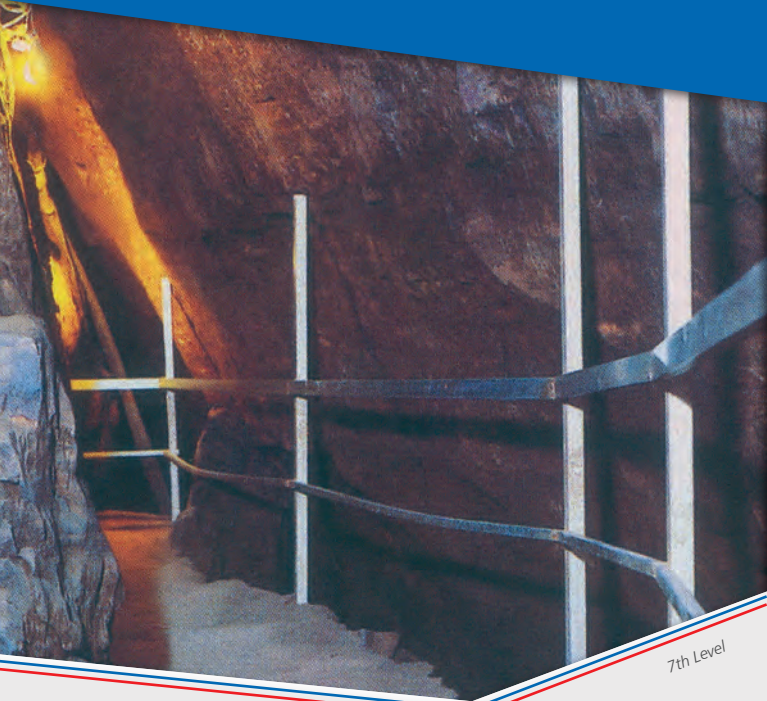

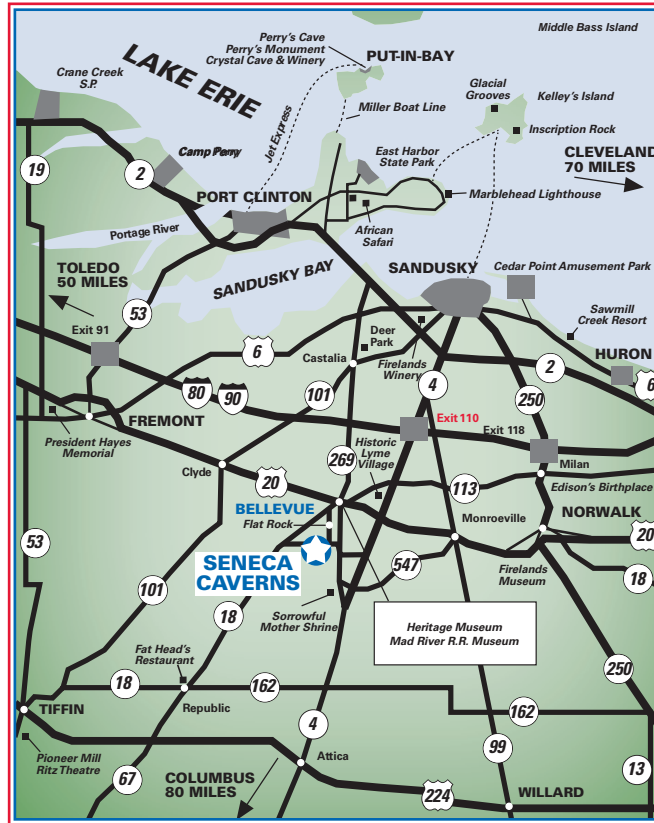

LOCATION

Four miles south of Bellevue off SR 269, or SR 18

FROM OHIO TURNPIKE (I 80 AND I 90)

Leave Turnpike at Exit 110. Take SR 4 south 8.8 miles to Seneca Caverns' directional sign. Turn right at Seel Road and follow signs.

FROM SOUTH

SR 4 N to SR 269 N - Follow Seneca Caverns' signs.

Explore Seneca Caverns

The cavern is electrically lit and an expert guide conducts the one-hour tour. A light jacket is recommended, as the temperature is a constant 54° F/12.2° C. Walking shoes are suggested. Tour is not wheelchair or stroller accessible. Carrying children is not recommended. Backpacks are not permitted. The cave tour is moderately strenuous.

life's passion was the preservation of this natural underground wonder. His devoted mentorship and enthusiasm in educating others, especially children and geology students, will endure through all he taught.

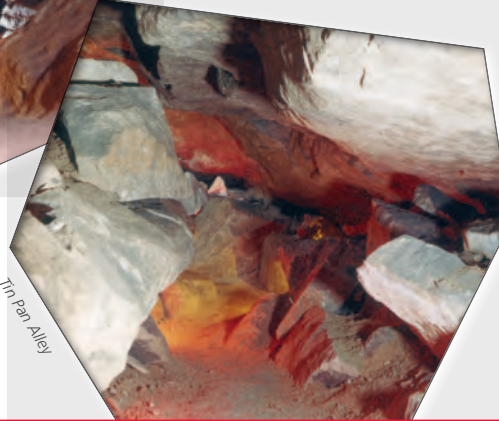

View "Ole Mist'ry River", the crystal-clear flowing stream, which is part of the vast groundwater system that underlies the region.
