- 1 **The Black Bear** is one of our Lodge buildings offering Adirondack style accommodations for families, groups and outdoor enthusiasts. Family game room on lower level.
- 2 **The Waterside Pavilion** is where weddings and outdoor events take place and presents you and your guests with panoramic views of the mountains and the Esopus Creek.
- 3 **The Catamount** Wedding and event venue that offers stunning views of Mount Tremper and the Esopus Creek through floor to ceiling windows and outdoor deck seating.
- 4 **The Grey Wolf** is one of our Lodge buildings offering Adirondack style accommodations for families, groups and outdoor enthusiasts.
- 5 **The Pool** is typically open Memorial Day through Columbus Day weekends.
- 6 **Emerson Park** is where fun for everyone can be had. Featuring a playground and picnic tables, it's a perfect place to spend an afternoon while enjoying a game of volleyball, badminton or horseshoes.
- 7 **The Catamount Dog Park** is a 60-foot wide by 100-foot long dedicated fenced-in area for canines that provides a safe haven for your pet to run, relax, mingle and make friends!

- 11 **The Fitness Center** features free weights, cardio equipment and fitness classes.
- 12 **The Great Room** is a spectacular space with floor to ceiling windows. Relax next to the fireplace with a book from our library or play a game with the family. The Great Room is an adaptive space for special events or meetings.
- 13 **Woodnotes Grille** serves breakfast and dinner, using Catskill Creative Cooking style. Enjoy a menu of locally sourced foods and handcrafted cocktails.
- 14 **The World's Largest Kaleidoscope** is housed in a 56-foot tall silo and wows audiences with a multi-media show combining brilliant moving images and theater-quality sound.
- 15 **The Kaleidostore** displays a collection of spectacular kaleidoscopes, many of which are one-of-a-kind pieces designed by artists from around the world.
- 16 **Emerson's Toy Chest** has a variety of toys, books, stuffed animals and educational items.
- 17 **Melina's Boutique** features a selection of women's fashions such as Lila P, White + Warren, Barbour, Three Dots and more.
- 18 **The Men's Shop** offers casual men's clothing from top brands such as Barbour and Woolrich.

- 19 **Waldo's Trading Post** is your stop for Catskill Mountain apparel, souvenirs and outdoor activities for kids. Forget something? Stop in Waldo's for a variety of personal care essentials.
