ZONE DESCRIPTIONS

<u>Zone 1</u>: On the Courtois: Berryman to Misty Valley— 4.6miles:

- Moderate canoeing, but beginners welcomed
- Gorgeous tributary to the Huzzah
- May drag in places, crystal clear waters, gorgeous bluffs, great for snorkeling

<u>Zone 2</u>: On the Courtois: Butts Slab to Courtois Primitive Area—5.0 miles:

- Moderate canoeing, but beginners welcomed
- Gorgeous fast runs, beautiful snorkeling holes, cave ecology

<u>Zone 3</u>: On the Courtois, Huzzah, and Meramec: Courtois Primitive Area to Resort—5.6 miles:

- Moderate to beginner canoeing
- Starts out with lots of turns, ends with the wider Meramec

Zone 4: On the Huzzah: Harpers Slab to Hwy 8—5.5 *miles*:

- Moderate canoeing, but beginners welcomed
- Exquisite bluffs and holes with great snorkeling and swimming areas
- More paddling than other zones, but quiet

Zone 5: On the Meramec: Bluffs to Resort—9.9 miles:

- Easier canoeing for beginners, longest paddling zone
- Quieter section of the Meramec
- Spring branches and nice bluffs

<u>Zone 6</u>: On the Meramec: Ozark Outdoors Riverfront Resort to Campbell Bridge—4.9 miles:

• Great for beginners, easiest and most relaxing zone
