- Take Interstate 95 North to Exit 20
- Turn right onto Hollywood Boulevard.
- Proceed east 2 miles to Historic Downtown Hollywood
- Proceed east 3.5 miles to Ocean Boulevard (Route A1A)

Restaurants, ice cream shops and charming hotels border a 2.5 mile (4 km) car-free oceanfront "Broadwalk" creating an amazing path for rollerbladers, bicyclers and joggers. If you're seeking a quieter pace, head to North Beach.

HOLLYWOOD BEACH BROADWALK

An oceanfront promenade ideal for skating, bicycling, jogging or strolling amid seaside lodgings, cafes, and shops. Live music almost nightly at the outdoor Hollywood Beach Theater at Johnson Street. Located in between Sherman Street & Monroe Street.

ADA ACCESSIBI E BEACHES

Hollywood Beach is the first destination in Florida to offer Mobi-Mat wheelchair access mats, providing convenient access to the beach. The Mobi-Mats are located at Carolina Street, Connecticut Street (Charnow Park), Johnson Street (just south of Bandshell), New York Street, the ADA Ramp between Tyler & Harrison Streets (behind Hollywood Beach Resort/Oceanwalk Mall), Harrison Street, Oregon Street and Magnolia terrace.



hollywood trolley

The Hollywood Trolley makes getting around Hollywood Beach and Downtown a breeze. Visitors and residents can board the trolley at more than a dozen convenient locations near Hollywood's major activity and parking areas.

- Departs approximately every 40 minutes from over a dozen stops on Hollywood beach and historic downtown


