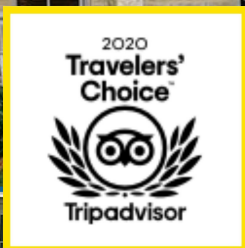
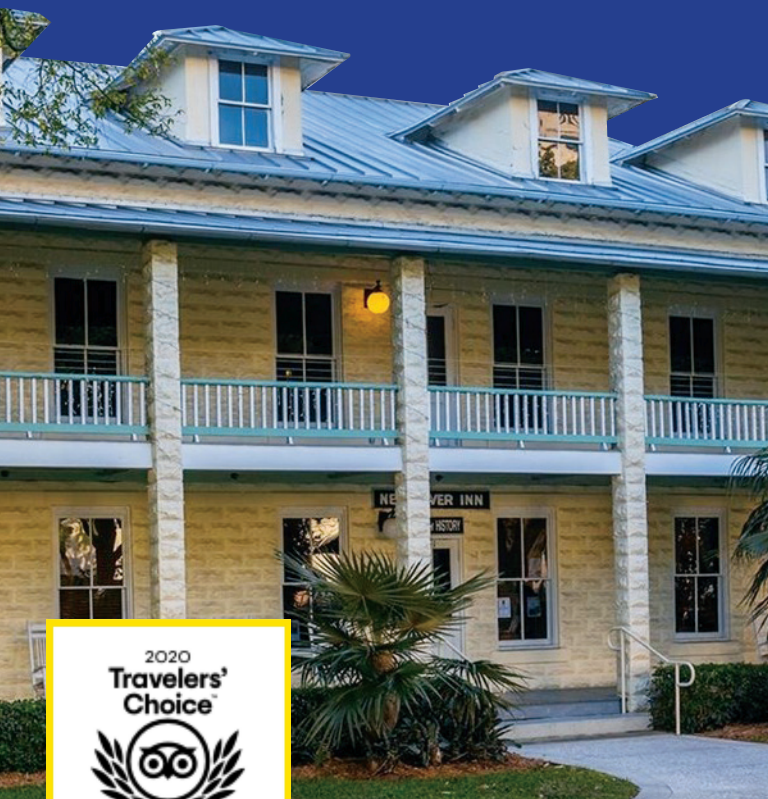

HISTORY MUSEUM

Today's Museum is housed in Broward County's oldest hotel – the 1905 New River Inn. Exhibits include Archaeology, Seminole Culture, Fashion & Military history.



1907 PIONEER HOUSE MUSEUM

Constructed of local pine and salvaged ship timbers by Ed King, pioneer farmer & builder. Period furnishings, clothing, antique doll and toy collections.



1899 SCHOOLHOUSE MUSEUM

Complete with period wood desks and McGuffey readers. Broward's first teacher, Miss Ivy Cromartie, might enter at any moment with her 9 students.

HOCH HERITAGE LIBRARY & RESEARCH CENTER

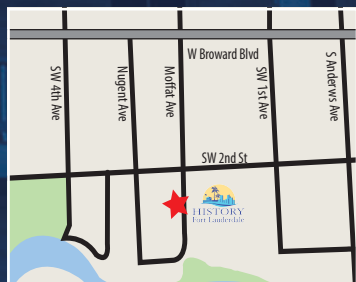
Originally a post office annex, the Fort Lauderdale Historical Society has called this warehouse structure its headquarters since 1978.
