Come view the most significant magnolia collection for conservation purposes outside China, where the majority of species originate.

- Stroll at your leisure with guidance from a free Magnolia Walk map and take in San Francisco Botanical Garden's prized specimens. including the cup-and-saucer Magnolia campbellii—the first of this species to bloom in the U.S. at SFBG in 1940; the 80 foot towering 'Strybing White'; the *M. dawsoniana*—a rare and endangered species from China; the *M. denudata*—the first magnolia introduced to the western world, dating back to the Tana Dynasty-618 AD; and the M. amoena-one of the last magnolias discovered in the wild.

- FREE Magnolia docent tours and hands-on interpretation stations on most weekends.

Open Daily at 7:30am in Golden Gate Park. Closed one hour after last entry. Last entry changes seasonally: 4pm in Jan; 5pm Feb-2nd Sat in Mar: 6pm 2nd Sun in Mar-Sept.

Entrances on Ninth Ave. at Lincoln Way (Main Gate) & at MLK Jr. Drive off the Music Concourse (Friend [North] Gate).

Use Main Gate for early entry. Friend (North) Gate opens at 9am.

Non-residents: \$8 general; \$6 youth 12-17 & seniors; \$2 children 5-11; FREE children 4 & under; \$17 families of 2 adults & children 18 & under

Limited free street parking is available in Golden Gate Park. Additional paid parking is located in the Music Concourse Garage. Bike racks are available outside each Garden entrance.
