### KENNEDY SPACE CENTER SPECIAL INTEREST BUS TOURS

**EXPLORE TOUR** – Visit launch pads, the Vehicle Assembly Building, and the NASA Causeway for a panoramic view of NASA and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station's rocket launch sites. Bus Tour: 2 to 2.5 hours.

**LAUNCH CONTROL CENTER TOUR** – The Launch Control Center is the heart of every space mission. See where engineers perform system checks leading up to a launch. Bus Tour: 2.5 to 3 hours.

**CAPE CANAVERAL EARLY SPACE TOUR** – Visit the historic places where America's space program was born. The past meets the present as the tour enters Cape Canaveral Air Force Station to view iconic space-related landmarks of the Mercury and Gemini launches. Bus Tour: 3 - 3.5 hours.

**ID REQUIREMENTS** - Please check in at Information 45 minutes prior to your tour time. For American citizens, a U.S. government issued Driver's License or U.S. State ID card is required for all tour participants age 18 and over. International adult and child participants must present a valid passport to participate. Please arrive at the designated tour boarding area at least 15 minutes before tour departure time.



**KSC SMARTGUIDE** - A portal to the NASA story with carefully curated content, video and photography that illustrates the spaceflight operations of Kennedy Space Center. Available for rent in eight languages. For the visually and hearing impaired, American Sign Language and an English descriptive audio tour available. Visit Information.

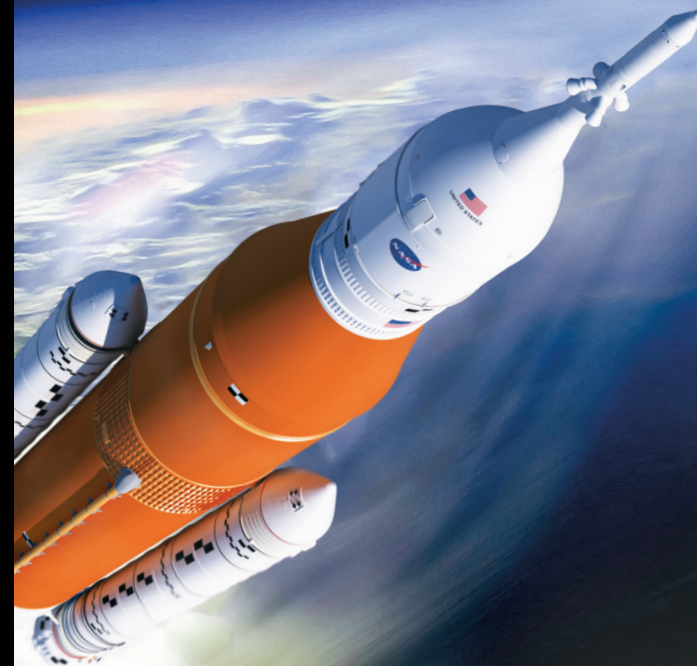

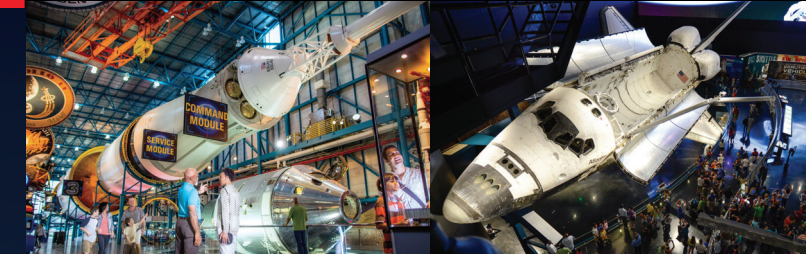

**HEROES & LEGENDS FEATURING THE U.S. ASTRONAUT HALL OF FAME®**  
*Presented by Boeing* – Relive the thrills and celebrate the pioneers of NASA's early space programs which inspired a nation to reach for the stars. Allow 1 hour.

**SPACE SHUTTLE ATLANTIS®** – After 126 million miles of space travel, an American icon landed here. More than 60 exhibits and simulators immerse you in a true-to-life spaceflight experience. Allow 2 hours.

**SHUTTLE LAUNCH EXPERIENCE®** – Strap in for the sights, sounds and excitement of a space shuttle launch. Guests with motion sensitivities or other health concerns can still enjoy the mission briefing pre-show prior to the ride. 44" height minimum.

**ROCKET GARDEN** – Walk among towering rockets that tell the story of humankind's quest for the stars. Expert-led tours available. Allow 30 minutes.

**KENNEDY SPACE CENTER BUS TOUR** – The only way to get a glimpse of the entire working spaceflight center. Departs every 15 minutes, bringing guests to the Apollo/Saturn V Center with a drive-by of a launch pad and the Vehicle Assembly Building. Allow 2.5 hours including Apollo/Saturn V Center.

**APOLLO/SATURN V CENTER** – Touch a moon rock, witness liftoff of Apollo 8 and stand beneath the largest rocket ever flown.

**ASTRONAUT ENCOUNTER** – Meet an astronaut and hear spaceflight stories. Encounter includes time for questions and photos. Allow 40 minutes. Located at the Universe Theater

**MISSION STATUS BRIEFINGS** – You'll receive a briefing from a space expert on Kennedy Space Center, recent and upcoming NASA activities and more. Allow 20 minutes. Located at the Universe Theater

**EYES ON THE UNIVERSE: NASA'S SPACE TELESCOPES 3D** – View the farthest reaches of the universe during this live 3D 4K resolution presentation through the eyes of the Hubble Space Telescope. Allow 20 minutes. Located at the Universe Theater

**JOURNEY TO MARS: EXPLORERS WANTED** – Join NASA on the pathway to Mars and the next giant leap of space exploration with live shows and interactive exhibits. Allow 30 minutes.

### IMAX® THEATER

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to film start time. No admission after movie has started.

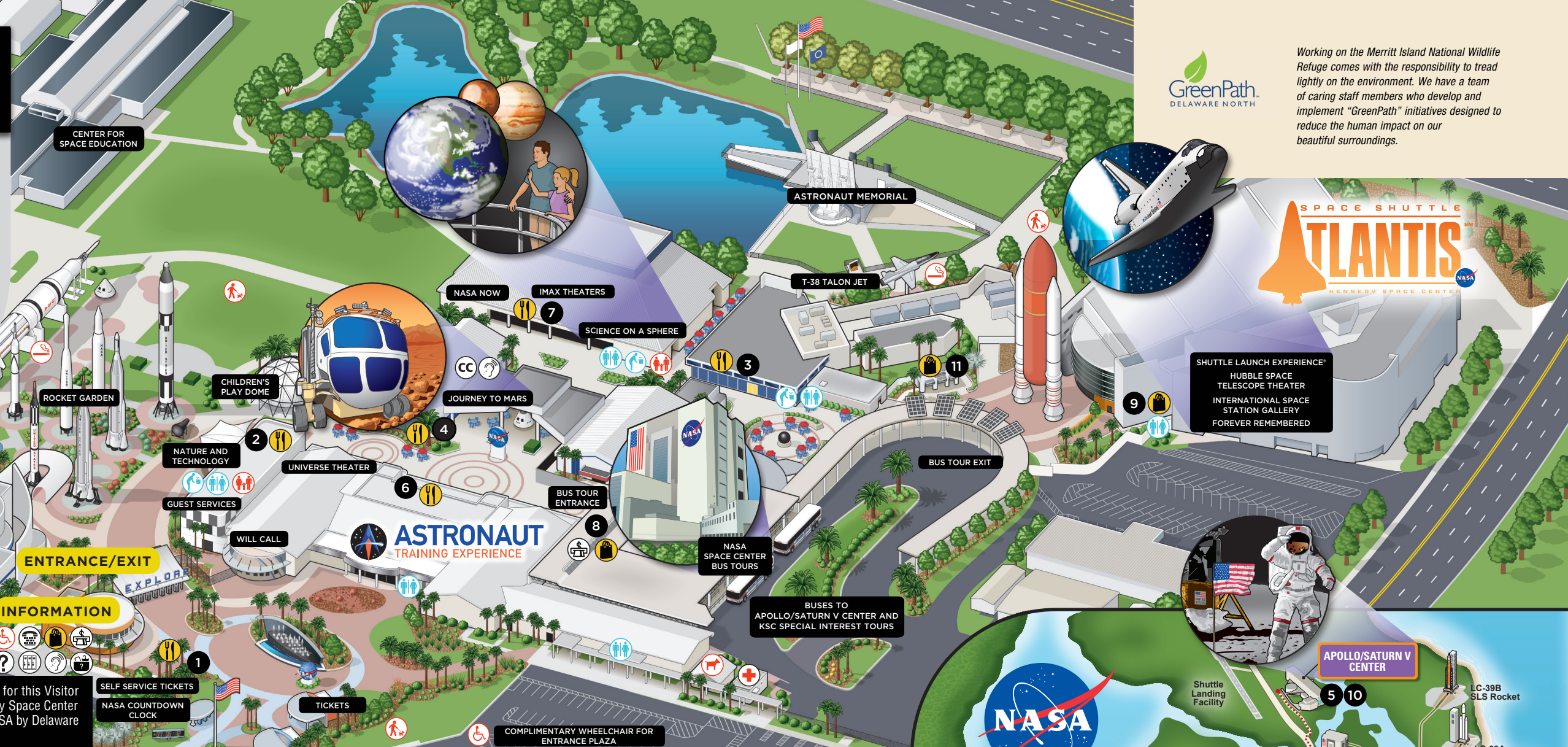
