SEPTA: Bus routes 7, 32, 33, 38, 48 and by Regional Rail - Suburban Station or 30th Street Station.

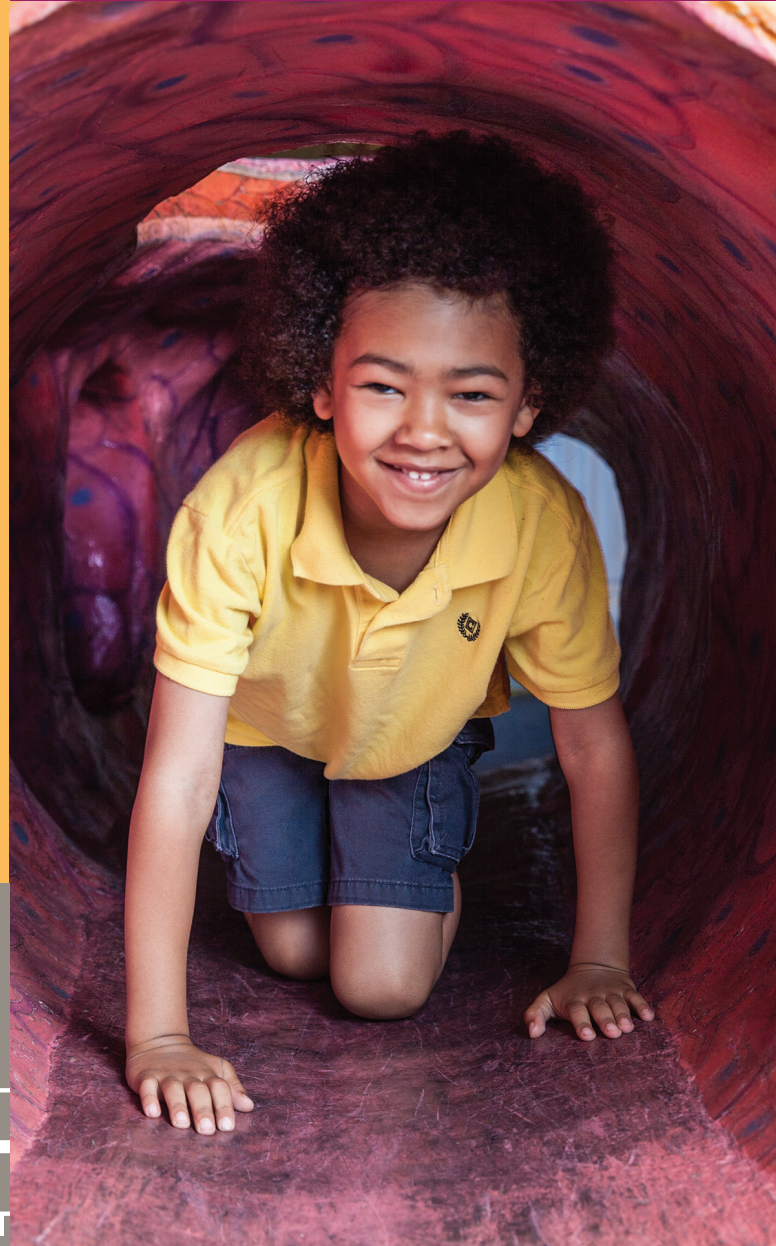
PATCO: The 15th-16th Streets and Locust station is a short cab ride away.
