FAIR TICKET INFORMATION

BUY YOUR DISCOUNTED ADMISSION TICKETS BEFORE AUGUST 10 AND SAVE OVER 30%.

Adults (ages 12 and over) are \$8; children (ages 6-11) are \$4. Children ages 5 and under are FREE every Fair day.

FOOD TICKETS

Purchase food tickets in advance in packs of five. Each food ticket is good for \$1 toward food and beverage purchases on the Fairgrounds. (Only available for purchase at the lowa State Fair Ticket Office.)

THRILL PARKS

In 2017, the super spectacular ride areas on the Fairgrounds will get a facelift and be called Thrill Parks. Within the lowa State Fair Thrill Parks there are three separate areas designed for different ages and levels of entertainment: Thrill Town, Thrill Ville and Thrill Zone.

All buses are wheelchair accessible. Cash only.
