MUSEUM LOCATION

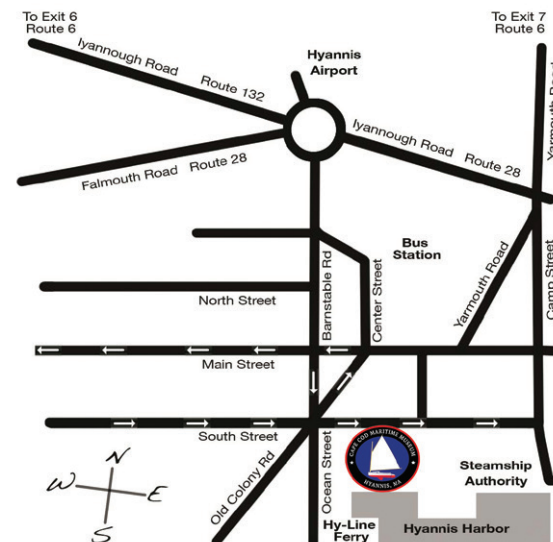

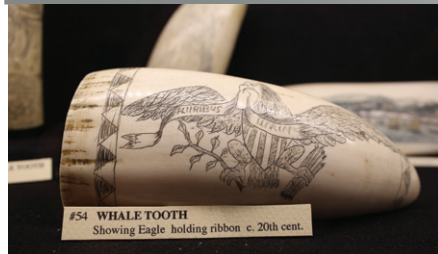
John Stobart: An Artist's Voyage
