From I-95, take the 45th Street exit east. Turn left onto Broadway/US-1 N/FL-A1A/FL-5. Turn right onto 59th St. Turn left onto N. Flagler Dr. and Manatee Lagoon's entrance will be on your right.

From Florida's Turnpike take EXIT 107 toward FL-710/Beeline Hwy., keep right at the fork in the ramp. Turn left onto Jog Rd. Turn left onto Beeline Hwy/FL-710. Continue to follow FL-710. Turn right onto N. Congress Ave. Turn left onto 45th St. Turn left onto Broadway/US-1 N/FL-A1A/FL-5. Turn right onto 59th St. Turn left onto N. Flagler Dr. and Manatee Lagoon's entrance will be on your right.

From U.S. Highway 1 (heading north or south), take 58th Street in West Palm Beach east toward the water. Turn left (north) at the end of the street and Manatee Lagoon's entrance will be on your right.
