Directions

From Muscatine

- US-61 N exiting Muscatine
 - Left on to Marquette Street
 - Left on to W 4th Street
 - Right on Division Street.
- The Putnam will be on your left at the top of the hill.

From Des Moines

- I-80 E towards Davenport
- Exit 290 for Interstate 280
- Exit 1/ Kimberly Road
- Right on Kimberly Road
- Slight right on to Hickory Grove Road, continue on N Division Street
- Right on to 12th Street

From Chicago

- I-88 W
- Exit 1B, I-80 W/ Des Moines
- Exit 295A to merge on to US-61S toward Brady Street
- Right on to W Kimberly Road
- Left on to N Division Street
- Right on to 12th Street

From Peoria, IL

- I-74 to Moline
 - I-280 W to Moline/Rock Island
 - Take Exit 4 for US 67/State St. toward Grant St/Riverfront
 - Left on to Grant Street
 - Slight left on to River Dr.
 - Right on E 4th
 - Right on Division Street.
- The Putnam will be on your left at the top of the hill.
